



## **ANCIENT LIGHT 88 MASONIC LODGE BURSARY**

This bursary has been established by Ancient Light for a deserving Ladner area student that has either overcome adversity or has contributed to community service.

Details of the bursary are as follows:

- Awarded annually in the amount of \$1000.00
- Available to all Ladner graduating students, who have the intent on pursuing post-secondary education.
- Recipient must be a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident
- Have been Ladner resident for at least two years.
- Selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by a committee comprised of the Assistant Superintendents and Principal representatives from Delta Secondary
- The bursary can be held for 15 months following graduation from grade 12
- The bursary will not be awarded if there are no qualified applicants in a given year
- A member of the Ancient Light Organization will present the bursary if they are available

To apply, students need to submit the following:

1. A written statement (maximum 500 words) describing how you overcame diversity or how you have contributed to community service.
2. Two reference letters, one from your school and one from your community.
3. Summary of your Activities and Accomplishments;
4. Transcript
