District Awards Information and Guidelines for Students

The District Awards recognize graduating students for excellence in their chosen area. These scholarships are intended to assist students in furthering their post-secondary education.

Value of the Awards:

Recipients will receive an award of \$1000 each, distributed in two parts: a \$500 cheque issued in October from the Ministry of Education and a \$500 voucher to be used exclusively for post-secondary education or training.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Open to all Grade 12 students who will be graduating in June of 2013.
- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant).
- A student may earn both a Provincial and a District scholarship.

Deadline:

Completed application forms must be submitted to the Career Centre, no later than Wednesday, April 17th at 3pm. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Selection Criteria:

- Must meet the eligibility requirements above.
- Demonstrate superior achievement in any <u>one</u> of the following areas:
 - Fine Arts: Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music, Creative Writing, etc.
 - **Applied Skills:** Business Education, Technology Education, Home Economics, SSA, ACE-IT and WEX (Work Experience).
 - Physical Activity: Not limited to PE 11/12 (school team sports, community sports
 - Second Languages (including Aboriginal Languages)
 - Community Service (Volunteer Activity)
 - **Technical and Trades Training** (ie. Carpentry, Automotive, Mechanics, Cooks Training)
- Meet the following criteria determined by the District Scholarship Committee:
 - Students must display superior achievement through 3 courses and/or activities related to the above areas.
 - One of the courses may be at the grade 11 level.
 - Courses for which External Credit has been received are also eligible.

Review Criteria and Process—note important dates!!

Step 1: Submissions will be reviewed by the school's Scholarship Committee based on the list of achievements, cooperation, demonstrated initiative, attendance and the written statement. Finalists for the awards will be determined and applicants will be notified.

Step 2: A list of FINALISTS will be posted on May 3. These applicants <u>may</u> be required to display evidence of their superior achievement in a digital format such as power point or video.

Of the applications submitted <u>25 recipients</u> will be selected, each of whom will receive \$1000.
