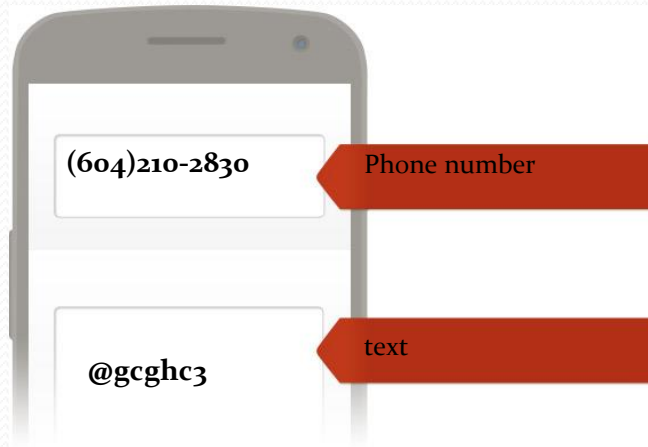

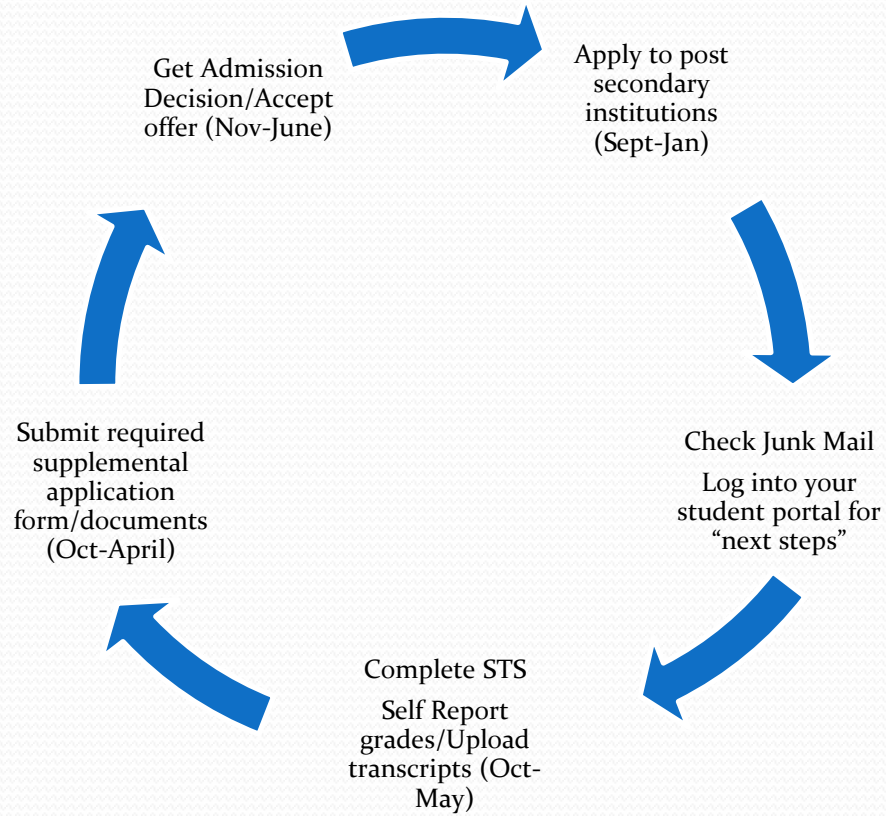

# **PRE APPRENTICESHIP FOUNDATION PROGRAMS AFTER HIGHSCHOOL**

## **What is it?**

- Training to prepare students for entry-level employment in a trade area of their choice.
- Apprenticeships can range from 1 to 5 years but most require 4 years to complete
- Where can I apply?
- Most schools offering trade programs have FOUNDATION programs:
  - BCIT
  - Kwantlen Polytechnic University
  - Vancouver Community College

## **Apprenticeship**

Upon completion of a program, students may seek employment as apprentices. Also receive their Level 1 training certification

## **Trades Discovery Program for Men and Women at BCIT**

- 16 week training program in approximately 15 different technical and trades fields (pre-test required for math & mechanical reasoning)

# Langara College

First come, first served (open enrollment)

## **Nursing:**

- New requirements include minimum 15 credits of post-secondary course work, with minimum C+ average (English, Biology, Statistics)

## **SFU-Langara Partnership Degree Program**

- Move between both institutions to complete BA, BSc , BHS from SFU
- Advantages: Pay Langara tuition rates, smaller class sizes, no paperwork to transfer to SFU
- Must apply to directly to SFU and also apply to Langara for priority course selection
- This is not the same as transferring from Langara to SFU

When applying to SFU: you select the “BA Partnership with Langara OR BSc Partnership with Langara”

- Must apply by January in order to be eligible to apply for scholarships

## Engineering Transfer

### Transferring to UBC

Completion of the Engineering Foundations Certificate program within a period of two consecutive semesters, with a minimum GPA of 3.1, meets the requirements of the UBC Engineering Transfer Program and makes you **eligible** for a seat in the second year of UBC's Engineering Degree program.

### Transferring to SFU

Completion of the Engineering Foundations Certificate can provide you with a guaranteed seat in the second year of SFU's Engineering Science Degree program, Mechatronics Engineering program or Sustainable Energy Engineering program.

- For non competitive 2 year Diploma programs, admission will be based on final Grade 11 marks (this applies to Trades programs as well)
- If grades are not met, will accept mid term grades
- Students must also be registered in the required Grade 12 courses (first qualified, first admitted – recommend student apply in Oct as seats fill up quickly)
- Competitive programs will be grade based+
- Must upload transcript at time of application
- Some trades program have a 1-2 year waitlist so apply now

## Broad based Admission

- All students for both campuses (Vancouver & Okanagan) are required to complete a Personal Profile as part of their admission requirements. This will also be used to assess their eligibility for the Presidential Scholars Award worth up to \$80,000 (Vancouver campus) and \$40,000 Okanagan campus



# Personal Profile

- Applicants to UBC are evaluated on a broad range of criteria. While UBC is looking for academically strong students, their answers to the Profile questions will demonstrate their preparedness for university studies.
- The Personal Profile allows them to tell UBC about the things that are important to them outside of academics
- Along with their academic achievements, the profile will be used to determine their admissibility to UBC's undergraduate programs.
- There is no separate application for entrance scholarships and awards so the online application is the only opportunity for them to tell UBC about themselves. This is their opportunity to shine!
- Focus less on listing and describing activities. Focus instead on what they have learned through these experiences. Their answers need to show self-reflection.

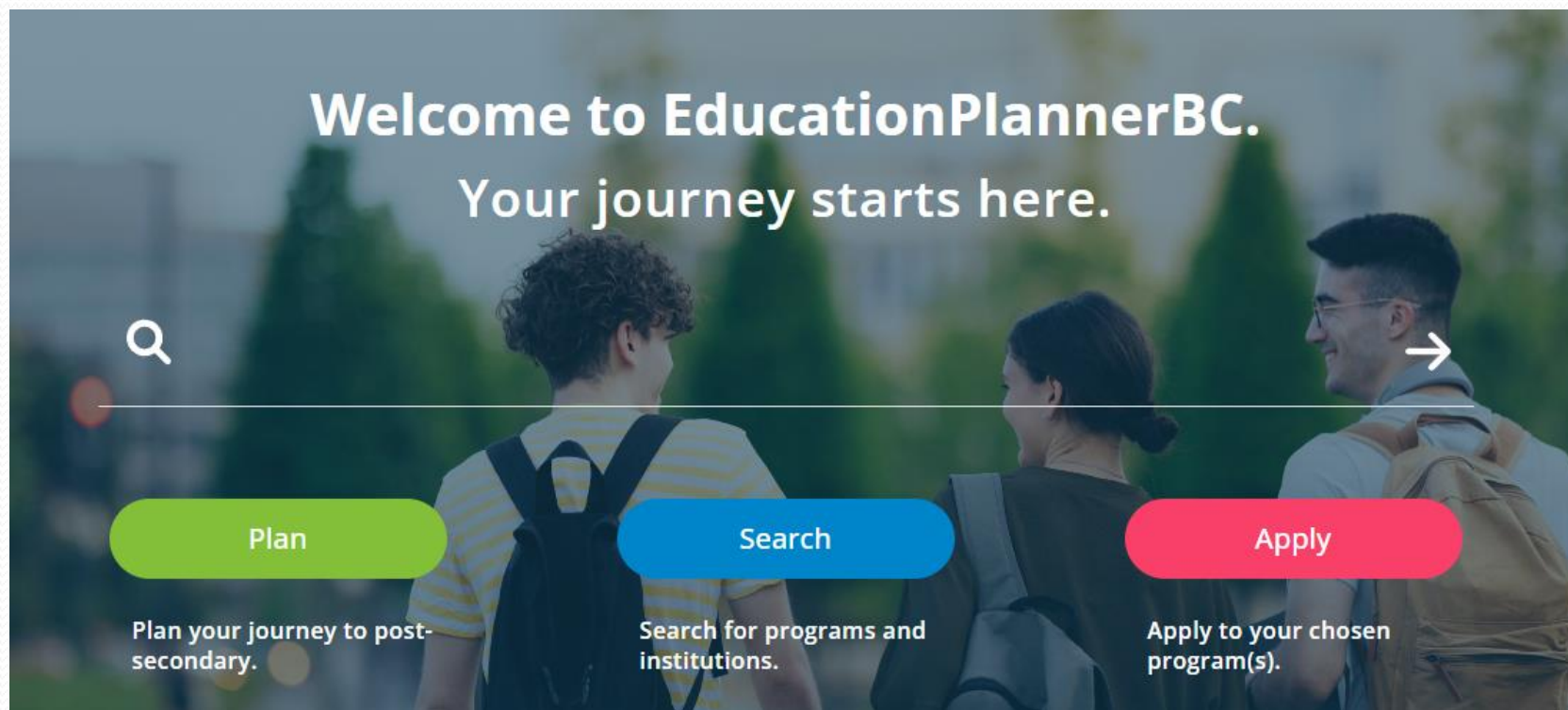

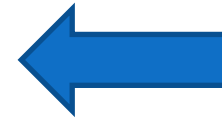

# Entrance Scholarships: UBC

## Presidential Scholars Award:

- One-time award of \$5,000 and renewable awards of up to \$80,000 payable over four years (\$40,000 UBCO)
- Personal Profile will be used for both admission and for the Presidential Scholars Award

- **December 1 deadline** includes: completed application form and application fee payment
- Must answer an additional question
  - “Please tell us why you should be considered for this award”

## UBC Centennial Scholars Entrance Award

- The purpose of this award is to **financially support** academically qualified students who may not be able to attend UBC without significant financial assistance

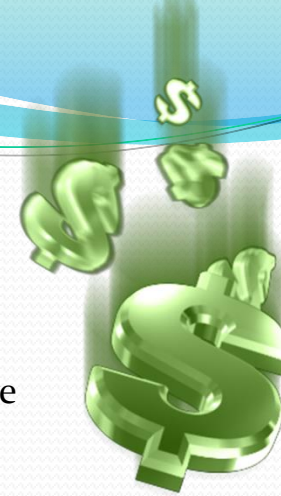
## Eligibility:

To be considered for the Beyond Tomorrow Scholars Award:

- You must self-identify as Black (African, African-American, African-Canadian, Afro-Caribbean)
- You must be a strong academic student and meet all UBC admissions requirements.
- You must demonstrate financial need.
- You must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected person in Canada.
- You must be entering directly from high school or transferring from another post-secondary institution.

# Entrance Scholarships: SFU



## SFU Undergraduate Scholars Entrance Scholarship

- Any student intending to apply to SFU with a 90% and above average
- Deadline: December 15, 2023
- Range: \$20,000 up to an amount sufficient to cover tuition and fees

Students applying to the Business program with a 90% + gpa do not need to submit a separate Broad Based application if they are applying to the Scholars Entrance Scholarship

## UGGLA Family Scholarship

- The scholarship program supports 10 exceptional students per year to study at SFU who may not otherwise be able to afford a university education.
- The program welcomes applications from candidates who identify as Indigenous, are Black or a person of colour, are living with a disability or are a member of the LGBTQIA2S+ community.
- The Uggla Family Scholarship is open to all Canadian/Domestic students who show leadership potential and is designed to significantly reduce financial and other barriers to participation in post-secondary education.
- 10 students will be admitted to SFU through the Uggla Family Scholarship each year
- Covers tuition, housing, meal plans
- Applications open early October
- Deadline: January 22, 2024

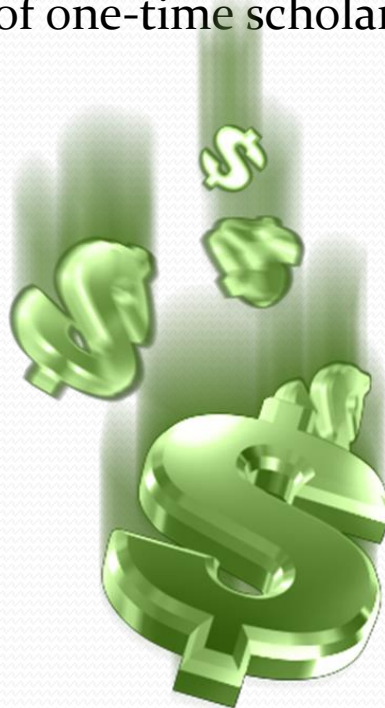

- For the 2023/2024 school year, 8000 top B.C. graduates with the highest cumulative average based on courses required for graduation (both required and elective) are eligible to receive a \$1250 scholarship voucher to use towards their post-secondary tuition.
- The Ministry will determine recipients based on students' achievement in Grades 10, 11, and 12 courses that satisfy graduation program requirements (including elective courses). A cumulative average percentage will be calculated and form the basis for awarding the BC Achievement Scholarship.  
Recipients must:
  - Meet basic eligibility requirements
  - Attain a "B" (73% or above) or better average in their Language Arts 12 course: English 12, Français langue première 12, or English 12 First Peoples
  - A student can receive only one BC Achievement Scholarship in their lifetime.



# Pathway to Teacher Scholarship

- The Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship (PTES) is awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment and aptitude for a career path in K-12 teaching. Each recipient will receive a \$5000 scholarship voucher to use towards tuition in their teaching program at a designated BC post-secondary institution.
- To apply, please complete the following application form and submit it to us along with all required documents by Feb 2024
- A student applying for this scholarship must meet basic eligibility requirements and be:
  - In their graduation year with graduation to occur by August 31
  - Eligible for a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma)
- Selection Criteria for Applicants
  - Meet basic eligibility requirements
  - Be eligible for a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma) and meet the requirements of the B.C. Graduation Program (2019) by August 31, 2024
  - Have at least a
    - "B" (73% or above) in your Language Arts 11 final mark
    - "B" average in final course marks that fulfill graduation requirements of Science 11 or 12, Math 11 and Social Studies 11 or 12, with no more than one "C+" (67% or above) final course mark, (marks lower than "C+" are not accepted)
  - Maintain a "B" average or better in Grades 11 and 12 final course marks required for graduation
