Scholarship Requirements

All required parts must be in 1 PDF document that can be emailed to taketwo@taketwoinc.com.

The order of documents is:

- 1) Cover letter which must answer the questions:
 - a. 'Something I am really passionate about is'
 - b. 'I am involved in my high school because'
 - c. 'I am taking/not taking a full course load in grade 12 because'
 - d. 'My next year plans are (university, college, year off, etc.)'
 - e. 'My future academic/career plans are'
- 2) Profile of all your school-related activities (please distinguish between volunteer hours for credit vs. hours not for any credits)
- 3) Letter of reference from either the school principal or vice-principal*
- 4) Letter of reference from one teacher*
- 5) Student transcript (or most current report card if all efforts are made and you are unable to get your transcript)
